## Photographer Regulations

1. Photographers must adhere to park hours. The park closes at sunset, as indicated at the Ranger Station.
2. Photographers are responsible for the conduct of their clients.
3. Photographers should call ahead to see if park activities are scheduled that may conflict with their use of state property.
4. No area is to be used for the changing of clothes other than the restrooms.
5. Candles, open flames of any type, glitter, confetti, balloons, and alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.
6. Photo setup cannot block walkways, steps, porches, or entrances of any of the historic structures.
7. Props cannot interfere with the aesthetic or historic visitor experience. Unattended props will be removed from the historic settlement.
8. Photographers may not move any park property from its designated location. This includes, but is not limited to doors, carpets, mats, chairs, and decorative items.
9. Clients are not allowed within restricted areas. This includes all cultural and natural resources such as historic structures and trees.
10. Plants and animals within the park are protected under State Law 62D and are not to be handled in any way. This is for your protection as well as the plants and animals within the park.

Failure to comply with these regulations will result in your privilege of conducting business in the State Park being terminated and may lead to prosecution. Management has the right to remove anyone from state property for noncompliance.
